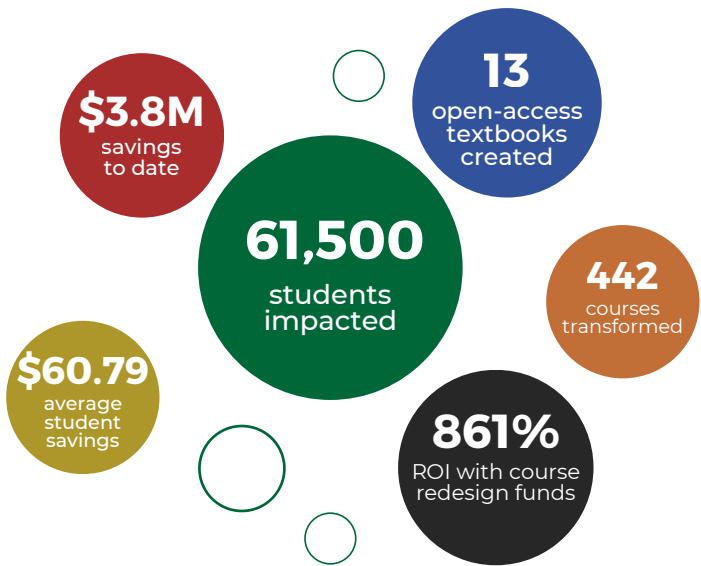




PALSave: PALNI Affordable Learning

49% of redesigned courses show grade improvement

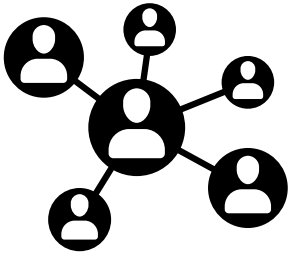


PALSave pays off
